

# **DEMOCRACY OPPORTUNITY SUPPORT FUND – DEMOS FUND**

# **Guidelines & Application Form for Applicants**

#### 1.0. **Background and rationale**

The Democracy Opportunity Support Fund (DEMOS Fund) is a flagship initiative of the West Africa Democracy Solidarity Network (WADEMOS) established with funding support from the Swedish International Development Agency (Sida). Set up as a transnational, civil society-led network in the ECOWAS Region, WADEMOS mobilizes, coordinates, and leverages the resources, opportunities, and collective power of its Members and other pro-democracy civil society organizations, social movements, and activists to defend, promote, and advance democratic values and reform in West Africa, including through engagement with relevant regional bodies and instruments. With its Secretariat based at the Ghana Center for Democratic Development, WADEMOS is governed by an 11-member Steering Committee, an Advisory Council and a General Assembly. For the current period through the end of 2024, the Network's five strategic priorities are: To

- Support in-country civil society actors to safeguard and assure peaceful and credible • elections and electoral outcomes.
- Protect against shrinkage of the civic space
- Protect and support at-risk frontline democracy and human rights defenders
- Support efforts toward democratic restoration in countries where democracy has collapsed
- Support national and regional efforts against violent extremism and terrorism. •

Complementing these strategic goals, the purpose of the DEMOS Fund is to respond to emerging openings and other opportunities, including early warnings, to defend, revive, or reinvigorate democracy in the Region.

#### 2.0. **Objectives**

The DEMOS Fund supports Network Members' (and Member-supported) initiatives to address democratic backsliding and respond to timely needed democratic interventions within the subregion. It specifically aims at:

Fostering collective, national, and regional actions and efforts in addressing democratic backsliding in West Africa around the five (5) pillars of the Network; this includes but not limited to initiatives aimed at enhancing the quality and credibility of elections; complementing ongoing regional and national efforts on transitional processes in Mali, Burkina Faso and Guinea, sustaining activism, pro-democracy campaign and mobilization in defense/advance of the rule of law and constitutionalism, freedoms and civil liberties; protection and prevention from abuse and suppression of Human Rights Defenders and Democracy Activist including the media, improving service delivery in fragile and transitional societies, among others.

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- Enhancing innovation and creativity among Pro-Democracy actors within the sub-region. •
- Improving timely and relevant democratic backsliding interventions and response within the sub-region

#### 3.0. **Guiding principles**

- The fund is competitive •
- The fund is accessible to Network Members. However, it supports external organizations • or individuals, and social movements. The application by external organization or individual and social movements should be supported by a recommendation from a Network Member organization.
- The fund is utilized to support two types of interventions in line with WADEMOS priority • areas:
  - Organizational projects from WADEMOS Network Members, recommended organizations or individuals and social groups addressing any of the five strategic priorities of the Network. This is funded under a six (6) months cycle and grants are awarded twice a year.
  - Timely-needed sensitive and immediate interventions from WADEMOS Network 0 members, and working groups in response to the democratic reversals at the national level. This may be co-created by WADEMOS and Network members, and on the recommendation or proposal from a Network member. This category of applications are opened throughout the year.

#### 4.0. **Selection Criteria**

Projects are reviewed by the PMU and approved by the Fund Management Committee based on established criteria

## > The concept and the rationale

It should be clearly stated and aligned to the WADEMOS priority action. Thus, how it advances and support the cause and objectives of WADEMOS in responding to democratic reversals at national and regional level.

### The scope and the purpose

- Regional and national advocacy and activism around the WADEMOS priority interventions
- Regional and national civic mobilization, civic engagement, solidarity engagements, capacity building, learning and knowledge transfer
- Other innovative democracy promotion initiatives including the use of creative talents and technology to respond to democratic backsliding

# > The Budget

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It should be realistic and respect the funding ceiling

- > The timeline
- Completion of projects and interventions should not exceed a period of six months. Funded Projects should be implemented only within the ECOWAS territory

# 5.0. Integration of Cross-Cutting issues

Projects are encouraged to integrate cross-cutting issues such as women and youth.

# 6.0. Budget Ceiling

The Ceiling for funding is as follows:

- Organizational Projects support: **\$20 000**
- Timely-needed Interventions including Individual and Social Movements: **\$10 000**
